Biography

Philomena Murray is Associate Professor in the School of Political Science, Criminology and Sociology and Director of the Contemporary Europe Research Centre at the University of Melbourne. She was awarded a Jean Monnet Chair in 2001 and a Personal Jean Monnet Chair (*ad personam*) in 2006. Her research interests are in European Integration analysis; EU-Australia relations; EU-Asia relations; EU governance and comparative regional integration. Recent books include *Australia and the European Superpower*, (Melbourne University Press, 2005) and P. Murray ed. *Europe and Asia: Regions in Flux*, Basingstoke, Palgrave Macmillan, forthcoming, 2008. She received a national teaching award, a Carrick Citation for Outstanding Contribution to Student Learning, in 2007, for pioneering the first European Union curriculum in Australia and leadership in national and international curriculum development through sustained commitment to student learning and research.
