Dr. Federiga Bindi holds the Jean Monnet Chair in European Political Integration and is a researcher the University of Rome Tor Vergata, where she also directs the European Office. In the past she has been teachingat the University of Florence, at Sc.Po. Lille and in a number of US Universities – Italy programs, such as NYU, SUNY-FIT, CSU, Florence University of Arts, John Cabbot, American University of Rome, Florence University of the Arts.

Dr. Bindi holds a Ph.D. in Political Science from the European University Institute (Florence). She is currently writing a book about Italy and the European Union for Palgrave.
